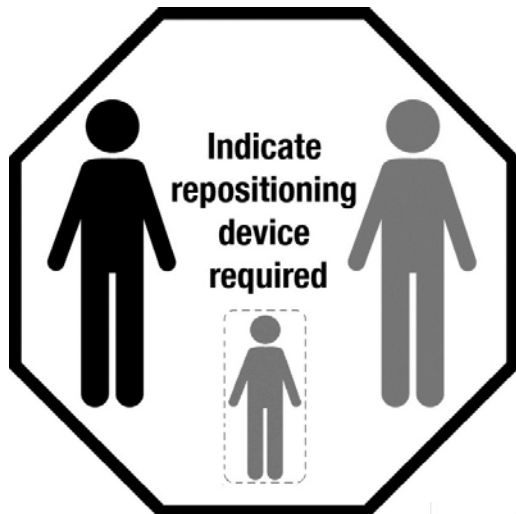

In TLR, a reposition is a moving technique:

- to turn, move or adjust a client's entire weight on the same surface or between two surfaces of equal height
- used by workers trained on the technique and equipment
- that is a dynamic and cooperative (physically and mentally) action between the client and worker when the client is able to assist
- that uses the least amount of manual effort by the worker
- that requires no lifting by the worker
- that most often requires a **minimum** of two workers
- that most often requires the appropriate equipment/device
- that may require one or more assistants to manage attachments and/or equipment

Workers always consider the risk of abusive/violent behaviour, be trained to recognize potentially violent situations, as well as how to respond to and report violent incidents.
