- Flammable
- Self-Reactive
- Pyrophoric
- Self-heating
- In Contact with Water, Emits Flammable Gases
- Organic Peroxide



- Irritation (skin or eyes)
- Skin Sensitization
- Acute Toxicity (harmful)
- Specific Target Organ Toxicity Single Exposure (drowsiness or dizziness, or respiratory irritation)
- Hazardous to the Ozone Layer



- Carcinogenicity
- Respiratory Sensitization
- Reproductive Toxicity
- Specific Target Organ Toxicity Single or Repeated Exposure
- Germ Cell Mutagenicity
- Aspiration Hazard
