

Professional Assault Response Training (PART®) program® Delivery Guide

Options for program delivery

1. Online Education – self-directed learning:
 - This course does not deem someone “trained” in PART
2. Split Classroom – online education (mandatory completion prior to classroom training) followed by facilitated classroom training within six (6) weeks of taking online education.
3. Traditional facilitated classroom training:
 - workers attend a classroom session facilitated by a SASWH approved and current trainer.

Online Education for Basic, Intermediate and Advanced

PART Basic	PART Intermediate	PART Advanced
completion of online plus 3 hours +/- classroom to review theory, role play, have discussion	completion of online plus 5 hours +/- classroom to review theory, role play, have discussion and adequate time to demonstrate techniques, have each participant practice and provide a return demonstration	completion of online plus full day classroom to review theory, role play, have discussion and adequate time to demonstrate techniques, have each participant practice and provide a return demonstration

Traditional classroom training recommendations (page 98 PART Trainer Manual)

Program level	Duration	Ratio
Train the Trainer	3 days	1 instructor for 6 trainer candidates
▪ Recertification	1 day, within three years of initial certification (two years if teaching Advanced)	
Basic	8 hours over one day	1 instructor or trainer for 12 participants
▪ Re-evaluation	4 hours once every three years, OR 1-1.5 hours once a year	
Intermediate	12 hours over two days	1 instructor or trainer for 8 participants
▪ Re-evaluation	6 hours once every three years OR 2 hours once every year	
Advanced	16 hours over two days	1 instructor or trainer for 8 participants
▪ Re-evaluation	8 hours once every two years OR 4 hours once every year	

PART requires regular re-evaluation every 3 years (two years for Advanced). If a participant is not current in PART training and has expired past the three years from initial training, a general participant session is required. If a participant requires a re-evaluation, the re-evaluation can only be for the program level of initial training.
